Clock Tower - Pope County Tribune Article

“We’ve seen exciting developments with the Clock Tower,” Strom shared. “The electricians have done incredible work. They removed outdated electrical lights and abandoned lines. Asmus Electric reinstalled the lighting, adding photo sensors where necessary. They also restored power to the top of the tower and replaced the lights to illuminate the clock faces.”

John Thomas, a horologist from Villard, has also played a key role in the restoration. “John worked on the clock tower motor and mechanism,” explained Strom. “He replaced gears and other internal components while adjusting and tightening set screws. The clock faces are now synchronized to within a minute or two of each other.”
